

Short articles section**DESCRIPTION**

The articles in this section usually focus on a concrete case study and include a local or regional analysis. Therefore, they do not need to have the same in-depth theoretical engagement as the long articles. The methodological section should also be more concise, in order to save space for explaining the core argument and the case study. Discussion of secondary literature should be limited to the introduction, as the core of article should focus on the concrete case study.

STRUCTURE AND CONTENT

The article must contain:

- *Title of the article.*
- *Abstract (150 words max), in English and Spanish.*
- *Keywords (3-5), in English and Spanish.*
- *Name of the author and his/her institution.* This information will be published in the article.
- *Email address.* This information will be published in the article.
- *Postal address and twitter and facebook accounts (if available).* These will not be published in the article. They are required for sending a hard copy of the journal to the author and for communication purposes.
- *Tables and/or graphs (as separate files).*
- *Photos related to the article (as separate files, in **JPG format** and with the highest resolution possible – **at least 300 dpi**).*
 - *The text has to indicate where to include the photos, graphs and tables; include a caption and indicate the source of the image/data.*
 - *This information should be placed below the image, following this format:*
 - **Table 1. Xyxyxyxyxy zxxzxx zxxz. Source: Statistics of xyxy.**
 - **Graph 1. Xyxyxyxyxy zxxzxx zxxz. Source: Own elaboration.**
 - **Image 1. View of the region xyxyxyx. Author: Joan Garcia** (the person who took the picture)
 - *Other images, posters, illustrations:*
Image 1. Poster of the movement xyxyxyxyxy zxxzxx zxx. Source: Climate March, 2015.
- *Bibliographical references*

LENGTH, FORMAT AND REFERENCES

The article should be max. 12.000 characters (without including spaces but including references) and approximately 4 pages long, in the following format:

- Font: Times New Roman, 11pt.
- Space between lines: 1,5 lines.
- Space between characters: Normal
- Text distribution: Justified
- Margins: superior 2,5 cm, inferior 3 cm, left 2,5, right 2,5

The references should have the following format:

- *In-text reference* with the name of the author and the publication date; for instance: (White, 1997). In case of a direct quote, it has to include a page number, for instance: (White, 1967: 1205).
- *At the end of the article*, a list of bibliographical references, using the following guidelines:

- **They should not be used to reference journals or books**
- In the text, they will be indicated with superscript numbers: ^{1, 2, 3, 4...}
- The text of the footnote should be in Times New Roman, 8 pt.
