



## CALL FOR PAPERS

The journal *Ecología Política* invites authors to send article proposals for its next issue, **n. 56**.

The issue will be dedicated to the **Political Ecologies of China**.

It will cover both theoretical dimensions and specific cases of socio-environmental transformations and conflicts in China, as well as the socio-environmental impacts of Chinese capital in other countries, in relation to:

- Mining and fossil fuel conflicts, marine, agricultural, forestry, hydroelectric, urban, etc.
- Debates and contributions to political ecology from China.
- Cultural expressions and forms of eco-social mobilization in China.
- The role of political, social and economic actors of China in socio-environmental conflicts of other countries, and vice versa.

The issue will be published in **December 2018**.

### PROCEDURE AND DEADLINES FOR SUBMISSION

Submission of articles will take place in two steps.

1. Article proposal submission (**250 words max.**). Deadline: **9 July 2018**.

Once received, the proposals will be evaluated by experts in the subject and by the issue's guest editors. The authors whose proposals are selected will be invited to send a complete manuscript. **Invitation to submit the full manuscript does not ensure its publication**, as manuscripts will then undergo a further review process. Once the review process is completed, *Ecología Política* takes care of the translation to Spanish.

2. Submission of the final version of the article (to be translated from English to Spanish, if necessary): **16 September 2018**.

## ARTICLE FORMATS

The articles published in the journal must fit into one of the following sections:

Section	Description of the articles	Word-limit (including bibliography and notes)
<b>In-depth</b>	Detailed analysis of one of the main topics, from a broad perspective. It should have a theoretical component and/or a global focus.	4000 words (approx. 8 pages)
<b>Short</b>	With a regional or local focus and normally centred on a specific case study.	2000 words (approx. 4 pages)
<b>Opinion</b>	A personal and critical vision of the subject matter.	2000 words (approx. 4 pages)
<b>Resistance networks</b>	Address local or community resistance to socio-environmental impacts.	2000 words (approx. 3 pages)
<b>Referents of environmental thought</b>	Analysis of the work and contributions of a reference thinker in relation to the special issue of each number.	2000 words (approx. 6 pages)
<b>Review of books, webpages and reports</b>	Critique of a recent key publication (book, film, or other media) related to the issue's topic.	1000 words (approx. 1-2 pages)
